Riddle 10: The Grandfather's Gift

A grandfather gives his grandson a puzzle. "I have a certain number of coins," he says. "If I divide them equally among my 3 children, there will be 2 coins left over. If I divide them equally among my 4 grandchildren, there will be 3 coins left over. If I divide them equally among my 5 great-grandchildren, there will be 4 coins left over. What is the smallest number of coins the grandfather could have?"

Answer Key: Unveiling the Solutions

Answer to Riddle 1:

Chickens have 2 legs, and cows have 4 legs. Total legs = (20 chickens * 2 legs/chicken) + (30 cows * 4 legs/cow) Total legs = 40 + 120 = 160 legs.

Answer to Riddle 2:

Let the son's current age be 'x'. The father's current age is 'x + 30'. In 10 years, the son will be 'x + 10' and the father will be 'x + 30 + 10 = x + 40'. According to the riddle, in 10 years, the father will be twice as old as his son: $x + 40 = 2 * (x + 10)$ $x + 40 = 2x + 20$ $40 - 20 = 2x - x$ $20 = x$ So, the son is 20 years old, and the father is $20 + 30 = 50$ years old.

Answer to Riddle 3:

Zero (0). Multiplying any number by zero always results in zero.

Answer to Riddle 4:

The five consecutive numbers are 13, 14, 15, 16, 17. Their sum is $13 + 14 + 15 + 16 + 17 = 75$. Alternatively, the sum of 5 consecutive numbers is 5 times the middle number: $5 * 15 = 75$.

Answer to Riddle 5:

This riddle involves a trick. The time it takes to travel upstream and downstream is determined by the boat's speed relative to the water and the water's speed. However, the question asks how long it takes to travel 30 miles *upstream* and then *return* to its starting point. The key is that the question doesn't ask for the total time for a round trip, but the time for the *upstream* journey and then the *return*. The number becomes 5679, and $5 + 6 + 7 + 9 = 27$, which is divisible by 9.

Answer to Riddle 8:

Let 'x' be the number of packs of 12 buns and 'y' be the number of packs of 6 buns. Total buns = 144 Equation: $12x + 6y = 144$ We need to find non-negative integer solutions for x and y. We can simplify the equation by dividing by 6: $2x + y = 24$ This means $y = 24 - 2x$. Since 'y' must be non-negative, $24 - 2x \geq 0$, so $2x \leq 24$, which means $x \leq 12$.
