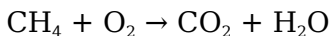

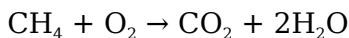

This is the core of the process. Start by balancing elements that appear in only one reactant and one product. It's often helpful to leave elements that appear in multiple compounds (like oxygen in this example) for later.

1. **Balance Hydrogen:** There are 4 H atoms on the left and 2 on the right. To balance H, place a coefficient of 2 in front of H_2O :

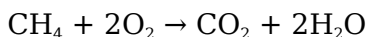


2. Recount Atoms:

Element Reactants**Products**

C	1	1
H	4	4 (2 x 2)
O	2	4 (2 in CO ₂ + 2 x 1 in 2H ₂ O)

3. **Balance Oxygen:** Now there are 2 O atoms on the left and 4 on the right. To balance O, place a coefficient of 2 in front of O₂:



4. Verify the Balance

Perform a final atom count to ensure that all elements are balanced.

Element Reactants**Products**

C	1	1
H	4	4
O	4 (2 x 2)	4 (2 in CO ₂ + 2 x 1 in 2H ₂ O)

The equation is now balanced!

Strategies for Tackling Balancing Chemical Equations Worksheets

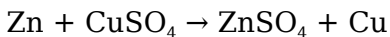
2. The "Least Common Multiple"

3. Balance Polyatomic Ions as a Unit

If a polyatomic ion (like SO_4^{2-} , NO_3^- , PO_4^{3-}) appears on both sides of the equation without undergoing a change within itself, you can often balance it as a single unit. For instance, in the reaction:



The sulfate ion (SO_4^{2-}) appears on both sides. You can see that Zn and Cu are unbalanced (1:1 on both sides).

Counting individual atoms, S is 1:1, and O is 4:4. Thus, this equation is already balanced!

4. The "1" Coefficient Trick

Remember that a coefficient of "1" is implied and doesn't need to be written. If, after balancing other elements, an element or molecule is left with a single atom or molecule, and it's the only thing that needs balancing, you've likely made a mistake. However, sometimes you might need to manipulate coefficients to avoid fractional coefficients. If you end up with a fractional coefficient (e.g., $\frac{1}{2} \text{O}_2$), multiply the entire equation by 2 to get whole numbers.

5. Use a Periodic Table and Reference Sheet

Keep a periodic table handy to quickly identify elements and their properties. A reference sheet with common polyatomic ions and their charges can also be invaluable.

6. Don't Erase Immediately

If you get stuck, don't panic or immediately erase. Sometimes, a slight adjustment or re-evaluation of your counts can resolve the issue. Work through the problem systematically.

7. Practice, Practice, Practice

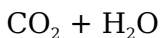
Not all reactions involve simple 1:1 or 1:2 ratios. Some require larger coefficients, especially those involving elements with multiple oxidation states or complex molecules.
