## **Pediatric Nursing**

Focusing on the unique needs of infants, children, and adolescents, this area assesses knowledge of common childhood illnesses, developmental stages, growth and

development, and age-specific care principles.

## **Psychiatric-Mental Health Nursing**

This component evaluates understanding of common mental health conditions, therapeutic communication techniques, patient safety in psychiatric settings, and the management of challenging behaviors.
