1. **Server Name:** `smtp.mail.yahoo.com`
2. **Port:** `465` (for SSL/TLS) or `587` (for STARTTLS)
3. **Authentication:** `Required` (Your email client must authenticate with the SMTP server using your YSB username)

4. **SSL/TLS:** `SSL` or `TLS` for port 465, `STARTTLS` for port 587.

Choosing between port 465 and 587 often depends on your email client's capabilities and its security protocols. Port 465 with SSL/TLS is generally considered more secure, while port 587 with STARTTLS offers a more flexible approach.

Username and Password

This is the most straightforward yet critical part of the configuration.
