Shylock, armed with a legally binding bond, demands strict adherence to the "letter of the law." He has every legal right to his pound of flesh. However, his insistence on this penalty, devoid of any compassion or consideration for Antonio's life, reveals the limitations of a purely legalistic approach.

Portia's Famous Speech on Mercy

Portia's celebrated "quality of mercy" speech is a pivotal moment. She argues that mercy is a divine attribute, an inherent part of human nature that cannot be forced or legislated.
