The novel's exploration of the dark side of the American Dream, its dive into drug-induced altered states, and its unflinching portrayal of excess and paranoia have solidified its place in literature. It serves as a potent reminder of the cultural shifts and anxieties of the late 20th century, while its themes of disillusionment and the search for authenticity remain perennially relevant. The influence of Hunter S. Thompson's *Fear and Loathing in Las Vegas* can still be felt today, in literature, film, and the ongoing cultural conversation about what it means to chase the American Dream.
