Bringing Villagers to Your Base: The "Moving" Process

Once you've found a village, the next step is to get the villagers to a location where you can manage them, whether that's a custom-built base or a secure trading hall. This often involves transporting them. Here are the most common methods:

Method 1: Boats - The Classic and Reliable Transport

Boats are an excellent early-game method for transporting villagers, especially if you need to move them across water or short distances on land.

1. **How it works:** Simply place a boat near a villager. They will attempt to pathfind into it. Once inside, you can paddle the boat to your desired location.
2. **Tips:** This method is safer and more controlled than trying to herd them. For longer distances on land, you might need to break and replace the boat to push them along. Be aware that villagers can still get out of boats if they encounter obstacles or if the boat breaks.

Method 2: Minecarts and Rails - For Longer Distances and Secure

Minecarts offer a more robust and efficient solution for transporting villagers over longer distances, especially across varied terrain.

3. **Brewing Potions:** You'll need a Splash Potion of Weakness and a Golden Apple. To brew a Splash Potion of Weakness, you'll need a Nether Wart, a Ghast Tear (for the awkward potion), and a fermented spider eye (made from spider eyes, sugar, and a mushroom).
4. **Applying the Potion and Apple:** Throw the Splash Potion of Weakness at the trapped zombie villager. Then, right-click the zombie villager with the Golden Apple in your hand.
5. **The Cure:** The zombie villager will begin to shake and emit red particles. Wait for the cure to take effect. This usually takes a few minutes. The zombie villager will then transform back into a normal villager.
2. **Benefits:** Cured villagers often offer significantly better trades than they did before being infected. This is a powerful way to get highly discounted items and valuable enchantments.

Breeding Villagers: Expanding Your Population

Once you have at least two villagers, you can encourage them to breed and increase your villager population.

1. **Requirements:**
 1. At least two adult villagers.
 2. Sufficient available housing (beds). Each villager needs their own bed, and there must be at least one more bed available than the current villager population.

2. **Iron Golems:** Villagers can spawn Iron Golems, which will defend them from hostile mobs. Building a village or a villager enclosure can encourage Iron Golem spawns.
3. **Iron Golem Farms:** For larger populations, consider building an Iron Golem farm, which not only provides iron but also offers protection.
4. **Height Advantage:** Villagers can sometimes wander into dangerous areas. Consider using fences or walls to keep them contained within safe zones.

Advanced Villager Mechanics and Tips

1. **Nitwits:** These villagers wear green robes and have no profession. They cannot pick up workstations or trade. Avoid attempting to assign them jobs.
2. **Profession Assignment:** Villagers without a profession will claim an available workstation within their proximity (usually within 10 blocks). This is how you assign professions.
3. **Villager Pathfinding:** Be mindful of villager pathfinding. They can get stuck on corners, wander into water, or fall off ledges.
4. **Trading Rates:** Hero of the Village effect (earned by

defeating a raid) significantly discounts villager trades.

5. **Zombie Villager Curing Bonus:** Cured villagers offer permanent discounts. This is a highly sought-after mechanic for acquiring rare items at a fraction of the cost.
