Opportunities for Showing Work

Look for worksheets that provide ample space for students to show their work, draw pictures, or write out their explanations. This is crucial for assessing their understanding of the process.

Gradual Increase in Difficulty

Ideally, worksheets should offer a progression in difficulty, starting with simpler problems and gradually introducing

more complex ones. This builds confidence and allows for mastery.
