The cognitive skills assessed are aligned with Bloom's Taxonomy, emphasizing skills such as:

1. **Recalling and Understanding:** Identifying key details, understanding vocabulary in context, and summarizing main ideas.
2. **Applying:** Using information from the text in new ways.
