A Scout's handbook is a traditional place for these documents, but a dedicated binder or a well-organized digital folder can also work. This ensures that all completed work is readily available for review by counselors and for the Scout's own reference.

Connect Learning to Real-World Experiences

Wherever possible, encourage Scouts to apply what they're learning from the worksheets to real-life situations. For instance, when working on the [Wilderness Survival merit badge](#), they can practice skills learned on hikes or camping trips.
