Employ precise scientific terms. Distinguish between concepts like mass and weight, energy and power, or speed and velocity. Correct use of terminology demonstrates your understanding.

Diagrams and Sketches

When asked to draw diagrams, ensure they are clear, labelled, and representative of the physical situation. For wave diagrams, label axes, peaks, troughs, and indicate wavelength and amplitude correctly.
