1. **Set up your Loom:** Arrange the pegs on your loom in a staggered pattern (like a zigzag). For a standard fishtail, you'll use three pegs across.
2. **Place the First Band:** Take one rubber band and twist it into a figure-eight shape (infinity symbol). Place this on the first two pegs, creating a base.
3. **Add the Second Band:** Take a second rubber band of a different color. Do NOT twist it. Simply place it on the second and third pegs.
4. **Add the Third Band:** Take a third rubber band of a new color. Again, do NOT twist it. Place it on the first and second

pegs, directly on top of the figure-eight band.

5. **The First Loop:** Using your crochet hook, grab the bottom band on the first peg (the one that was twisted into a figure-eight). Carefully pull it over the top of the peg and onto the middle peg.
6. **Repeat on the Other Side:** Now, move to the third peg. Grab the bottom band there and pull it over the top of the peg and onto the middle peg.
7. **Add a New Band:** Take a new, untwisted rubber band of a different color. Place it on the second and third pegs, covering the bands you just looped.
8. **Continue the Pattern:** You will now see three bands on each peg. Repeat steps 5 and 6: hook the bottom band from the first peg onto the middle peg, and the bottom band from the third peg onto the middle peg.
9. **Add Another New Band:** Take a new, untwisted rubber band and place it on the second and third pegs.
10. **Repeat and Extend:** Continue this process – looping the bottom bands from the outer pegs to the middle peg, and then adding a new untwisted band to the second and third pegs. As your bracelet grows, it will start to resemble a fishtail braid.
11. **Finishing the Bracelet:** When your bracelet is the desired length, you'll need to secure it.
 1. Stop adding new bands.
 2. Loop the bottom band from the first peg to the middle peg.

4. You should now have two bands on the middle peg. Hook the top band from the middle peg onto the first peg, and the bottom band from the middle peg onto the third peg.
5. You will have one band remaining on each of the first and third pegs.
6. Gently remove all the bands from the loom, keeping the remaining two bands on your hook.
7. Take one of your C-clips or S-clips and attach it to one of the remaining bands on your hook. Then, attach the other end of the clip to the other band. This will secure your bracelet.

Method 2: Finger Loom Method

This is a more basic approach, perfect for quick creations or when you don't have a loom handy.

1. **Start with Two Fingers:** Use your index and middle fingers as your loom.
2. **Place the First Band:** Take one rubber band and twist it into a figure-eight shape. Place one loop on your index finger and the other on your middle finger.
3. **Add the Second Band:** Take a second rubber band of a different color. Do NOT twist it. Place it around both of your fingers, above the figure-eight band.
4. **Add the Third Band:** Take a third rubber band of a new color. Do NOT twist it. Place it around both of your fingers, above the second band.
5. **The First Loop:** Using your thumb or the crochet hook (if you

have one), grab the bottom band on your index finger (the figure-eight band). Pull it up and over both fingers, releasing it.

6. **Repeat on the Other Hand:** Now, move to your middle finger. Grab the bottom band on your middle finger and pull it up and over both fingers, releasing it.
7. **Add a New Band:** Take a new, untwisted rubber band. Place it around both fingers, above the remaining bands.
8. **Continue the Pattern:** You will now see three bands on each finger. Repeat steps 5 and 6: loop the bottom band from your index finger over both fingers, and then the bottom band from your middle finger over both fingers.
9. **Add Another New Band:** Take a new, untwisted rubber band and place it around both fingers.
10. **Repeat and Extend:** Continue this process – looping the bottom bands from each finger over, and then adding a new untwisted band.
11. **Finishing the Bracelet:** When the desired length is reached, stop adding new bands. Loop the bottom band from your index finger over, then the bottom band from your middle finger over. You should have two bands remaining on each finger.
12. **Secure the Ends:** Carefully remove all the bands from your fingers. You'll have two bands remaining on your hook (or you can use your fingers to hold them). Attach a C-clip or S-clip to both of these bands to secure your bracelet.
