4. **Focus on Rationale:** Pay close attention to the rationale provided with each answer. This explanation is often more valuable than the question itself, as it details the clinical reasoning and evidence supporting the

correct choice.

5. **Categorize Your Mistakes:** Keep track of the types of questions or content areas you consistently miss. Are you struggling with pharmacology, specific disease management, or diagnostic reasoning? This data-driven approach allows you to focus your remedial study efforts where they are most needed.
6. **Utilize Reputable Resources:** Invest in high-quality practice question banks and review courses from well-established providers. Look for resources that are updated regularly to reflect current guidelines and exam blueprints. Some popular options include those from ANCC, AANPCB, and various NP review companies.
