Willpower (WIL): Stamina and Spell Resistance

Willpower determines your stamina, which is used to fuel many Warrior abilities, and your resistance to mental and magical effects. For Warriors who rely heavily on their active abilities, a moderate Willpower investment can be beneficial, allowing for more frequent use of powerful skills. It also provides a much-needed buffer against spellcasting enemies. However, for most Warrior builds, Willpower is a lower priority compared to Strength and Constitution.

Cunning (CUN): The Rogue's Domain, But...

Cunning primarily benefits Rogues, affecting their lockpicking, trap disarming, and critical hit chance with finesse-based attacks. For Warriors, Cunning has very limited utility, primarily contributing to your ability to spot traps and overhear conversations for optional dialogue. Unless you are aiming for a highly unconventional build or prioritize out-of-combat utility, Cunning can generally be ignored.

Magic (MAG): Little to No Impact

Magic has virtually no impact on Warrior gameplay. It is the domain of mages and spellcasters. As a Warrior, you will not be casting spells, so this attribute can be entirely disregarded.

Warrior Specializations: Tailoring Your Combat Prowess

Once you reach a certain level (typically level 7), you'll unlock the ability to choose a specialization. These specializations offer unique skills and passive bonuses that dramatically alter your character's capabilities. For Warriors, the available specializations are:

The Champion: The Stalwart Defender

The Champion specialization is all about survivability and team support. Champions gain access to abilities like **Combat Focus**, which significantly boosts their damage and defense, and **Saving Throw**, which grants a chance to negate incoming damage. Their ultimate ability, **Heroic Offense**, can turn the tide of battle by buffing the entire party's combat effectiveness. This specialization is ideal for players who want to be the unmovable object, drawing enemy attention and keeping their allies safe. A Champion build often emphasizes Constitution and Strength.

The Berserker: The Unstoppable Force

The Berserker is the epitome of offensive power. Berserkers can enter a devastating frenzy state, dramatically increasing

their attack speed and damage output with abilities like **Berserk**. They also gain access to **Mighty Blow** and **Cleave**, powerful offensive abilities that can cleave through multiple enemies. The Berserker specialization excels at dealing massive damage, often at the cost of some defensive capabilities. This build thrives on Strength and relies on other party members to mitigate incoming damage. Building around a Berserker often involves focusing on Strength and Dexterity for critical hits.

The Templar: The Anti-Mage Specialist

Templars are the bane of mages. They possess a unique set of abilities designed to counter spellcasters. Their signature ability, **Holy Smite**, deals significant damage to and disrupts magical effects. They also gain access to **Disruption**, which can drain an enemy mage's mana, and **Cleanse Wrath**, which can remove magical debuffs from allies. The Templar specialization is invaluable when facing enemy mages and is a strong choice for players who want a more tactical approach to combat, especially against spell-heavy enemy compositions. This build often benefits from a mix of Strength and Willpower.

The Reaver: The Dark, Powerful Warrior (Requires Return to Ostagar DLC)

The Reaver specialization, introduced with the Return to Ostagar DLC, offers a unique, risk-reward playstyle. Reavers can tap into their own life force to unleash devastating attacks and gain potent buffs. Abilities like **Blood Rage** and **Mortal Strike** allow them to sacrifice health for increased power.

This specialization is for players who enjoy a high-stakes, aggressive playstyle and are comfortable managing their health bar. A Reaper build often focuses on Strength and can benefit from the life-steal effects of certain weapons and armor.

Popular Dragon Age: Origins Warrior Builds and Playstyles

With the understanding of attributes and specializations, let's explore some effective Warrior builds:

1. The Unkillable Tank (Champion/Templar Focus)

Goal: To draw all enemy aggro and absorb as much damage as possible, protecting the rest of the party.

Attribute Priority: Constitution > Strength > Dexterity

Specialization: Champion (for survivability and party buffs) and Templar (for anti-mage utility).

Key Skills: Threaten, Taunt, Shield Bash, Combat Focus, Saving Throw, Holy Smite.

Weapon/Armor: Heavy armor is essential. A sword and shield combination is ideal for maximizing defensive bonuses and control. Look for gear with bonuses to Constitution, armor, and spell resistance.

during intense fights. If facing mages, employ **Holy Smite** to disrupt their casting.

2. The Two-Handed Destroyer (Berserker Focus)

Goal: To maximize damage output with devastating two-handed weapon attacks and abilities.

Attribute Priority: Strength > Dexterity > Constitution

Specialization: Berserker (for raw damage and attack speed).

Key Skills: **Mighty Blow, Cleave, Weapon Expertise, Berserk, Combat Trance.**

Weapon/Armor: Heavy armor is still recommended for survivability, but the focus is on the biggest two-handed weapons available. Look for gear that boosts Strength, critical hit chance, and damage.

Tactics: Charge into the thick of combat, targeting groups of enemies with **Cleave**. Use **Mighty Blow** on tougher single targets. Activate **Berserk** when you need to unleash maximum damage. While less durable than a tank, you'll be killing enemies before they can pose a serious threat.

3. The Dual-Wielding Savage (Berserker/Reaver Focus - potentially)

Goal: To deliver a rapid barrage of attacks with two one-handed weapons, focusing on critical hits and sustained damage.

Attribute Priority: Strength > Dexterity > Constitution

Specialization: Berserker (for attack speed and damage) or Reaver (for a riskier, high-damage playstyle).

Key Skills: **Dual-Wielding Expertise**, **Flurry**, **Twin Slashes**, **Berserk** (if Berserker), **Blood Rage** (if Reaver).

Weapon/Armor: Medium or Heavy armor. Focus on finding two powerful one-handed weapons. Look for gear that enhances Dexterity for hit chance and critical hits, alongside Strength.

Tactics: This build relies on applying constant pressure with rapid attacks. Position yourself to maximize hits. If using the Reaver, carefully manage your health when using **Blood Rage**. This build can be very effective but requires a bit more tactical positioning than a pure two-handed build.

Essential Warrior Talents and Abilities to Prioritize

Beyond your specialization, certain core Warrior talents are universally beneficial:

1. Warrior Talents:

1. **Weapon Expertise:** A prerequisite for many powerful weapon abilities. Max it out for your chosen weapon type (e.g., Two-Handed Weapon Expertise, Sword and Shield Expertise).
2. **Power of the Elements:** Grants bonus damage against specific enemy types, very useful.
3. **Mighty Blow / Cleave:** Essential damage-dealing abilities, especially for two-handed builds.

4. **Dual-Wielding Expertise:** Crucial for dual-wielding builds, increasing damage and hit chance.
 5. **Shield Bash / Shield Wall:** Core abilities for sword and shield users, providing crowd control and defense.
 6. **Threaten:** A passive talent that increases your threat generation, essential for tanks.
 7. **Taunt:** The ultimate aggro-drawing ability, vital for any tank.
2. **Rage Talents (if applicable to your build):**
1. **Rage:** Increases your damage and defense at the cost of stamina.
 2. **Berserk:** A powerful rage-based ability that significantly boosts attack speed and damage.
 3. **Improved Rage:** Enhances the benefits of Rage.

Gear and Equipment: The Finishing Touches

The right gear can significantly amplify your Warrior build's effectiveness. When looking for equipment, prioritize:

1. **Armor:** Always aim for the heaviest armor your Strength allows. Look for bonuses to armor, health, spell resistance, and relevant attributes (Strength, Constitution).
2. **Weapons:** Choose weapons that complement your build. For two-handed, aim for high damage. For sword and shield, consider weapons with parry or control effects. For dual-wielding, focus on speed and critical hit potential. Look for enchantments that boost Strength, Dexterity, or damage.
3. **Accessories:** Rings and amulets can provide crucial stat

boosts or resistances. Look for items that enhance your primary attributes or provide defensive buffs.

Party Composition: The Warrior's Companions

Your Warrior build will shine brightest when supported by a well-rounded party. A typical Dragon Age: Origins party includes:

1. **A Rogue:** For lockpicking, trap disarming, and ranged damage (like Leliana or Zevran).
2. **A Mage:** For crowd control, buffs, and offensive spells (like Morrigan or Wynne).
3. **Another Warrior or a specialised companion:**
Depending on your Warrior's role, you might want another frontline presence or a dedicated healer/buffer.

A tank Warrior will greatly benefit from a healer and crowd-controlling mage. A damage-focused Warrior will need companions who can hold aggro or provide support.
