The use of colloquialisms and idiomatic expressions in the Russian text further enhances the biting wit and realism of these scenes. Words like "быт" (everyday life) and "чиновники" (officials) take on a particular weight when seen through the lens of Woland's disruptive presence.

Margarita's role as a hostess at Satan's Grand Ball (*Бал у Сатаны*) is a pivotal scene, where she confronts and absolves the tormented souls of history. This scene is laden with allegorical meaning, exploring themes of justice, mercy, and the cyclical nature of human suffering. The Russian fascination with the mystical and the supernatural, often present in folk tales and religious thought, provides fertile ground for these profound explorations.

The Biblical Dimension: Pilate and Yeshua

The Master's novel delves into the trial and crucifixion of Jesus, referred to as Yeshua Ha-Notsri.
