With Rock Smash, the balance can be somewhat struck. As previously mentioned, some Pokémon can effectively utilize Rock Smash in battle while also serving their exploration purpose. This means a dedicated HM Slave might not be strictly necessary for this specific move if you choose wisely.

However, if your team is already packed with powerful attackers and you need to clear rocks frequently, dedicating a slot might be inevitable. Consider Pokémon that have a good Attack stat and can learn other useful HMs as well, such as Strength or Cut (though Cut is generally less useful in battle). This allows for greater flexibility and minimizes the impact on your primary combat team.

Conclusion: Rock Smash - A Foundational Move in HeartGold

Rock Smash may not be the flashiest move in Pokémon HeartGold, nor does it boast the highest base power. However, its importance to the player's journey cannot be overstated. From unlocking crucial pathways and revealing hidden treasures to offering a subtle yet significant strategic advantage in battle, Rock Smash is a foundational move that every trainer

will need to master. Understanding its acquisition, applications, and optimal usage will undoubtedly lead to a more fulfilling and successful adventure through the vibrant world of Johto and beyond.
