Log in to your PTV account online or call the PTV Hub immediately to report it. PTV can then block the lost card and help you transfer any remaining balance to a new Myki card.

Troubleshooting Myki Top-Up Issues

Occasionally, you might encounter issues with your Myki top-up. Here are some common problems and solutions:

1. **Online top-up not appearing:** As mentioned, online top-ups can take up to an hour. If it's been longer, check your PTV account to see if the transaction was successful. If it appears to have gone through but isn't reflecting on your card, contact PTV customer service.
2. **Myki machine not working:** Report the faulty machine to PTV or station staff. Try

another machine or a different top-up method.

3. **Card not reading:** Ensure your card is not damaged and is being presented correctly to the reader. Sometimes, simply cleaning the card can help.
