Mientras tanto, mi hermano (leer) ____ un libro interesante." (Yesterday, I ate a delicious apple. Meanwhile, my brother was reading an interesting book.) These exercises are excellent for basic conjugation practice and for initial application of the tense rules. They force the learner to consider the context and determine if the action was completed or ongoing.

Sentence Transformation

These exercises require learners to rewrite sentences, often changing the tense or combining sentences. For instance, a prompt might ask to rewrite a sentence from the present tense to a past tense, or to combine two sentences using a specific conjunction that signals a change in tense usage. **Example:** "I am walking in the park.
