1. Combining sets: "Sarah has 7 apples, and John gives her 5 more. How many apples does Sarah have now?"
2. Finding the total: "There are 12 red balloons and 9 blue balloons. How many balloons are there in total?"

These are often the first types of word problems students encounter and serve as an excellent entry point.

Subtraction Word Problems

These problems involve taking away a quantity, finding the difference, or comparing two quantities. Examples include:
