Animal Farm concludes with a scene that is both darkly ironic and profoundly disturbing. The other animals, peering through the farmhouse window, can no longer distinguish between the pigs and the humans. This final image signifies the complete metamorphosis of the revolutionary pigs into the very oppressors they once fought against. The **corruption of power** has rendered them indistinguishable from their former human masters, demonstrating the cyclical nature of tyranny when unchecked by vigilance and critical awareness.

Orwell's exploration of **power and corruption in Animal Farm** serves as a perpetual cautionary tale. It highlights the fragility of revolutionary ideals, the seductive nature of absolute power, and the importance of critical thinking, education, and active resistance in safeguarding against tyranny. The novel remains a potent reminder that the struggle for equality is an ongoing one, and that complacency and the unquestioning acceptance of authority can pave the way for the most profound betrayals.
