## 1. The "All From 9 and Last From 10" (Anuphant) Method: Multiplying by Numbers Close to a Base

### **Example: 98 x 97**

1. **Base:** 100
2. **Deficiencies:** 98 is 2 less than 100 (deficiency = 2). 97 is 3 less than 100 (deficiency = 3).
3. **Cross Addition:**  $98 - 3 = 95$  (or  $97 - 2 = 95$ ). This is the left part.
4. **Multiply Deficiencies:**  $2 \times 3 = 6$ . This is the right part.
5. **Adjust:** The base is 100 (2 zeros), so we need 2 digits on the right. We have 6, so we write it as 06.

**Answer: 9506**

### Example: 103 x 104

1. **Base:** 100
2. **Surpluses:** 103 is 3 more than 100 (surplus = 3). 104 is 4 more than 100 (surplus = 4).
3. **Cross Addition:**  $103 + 4 = 107$  (or  $104 + 3 = 107$ ). This is the left part.
4. **Multiply Surpluses:**  $3 \times 4 = 12$ . This is the right part.
5. **Adjust:** Base has 2 zeros, so 2 digits on the right. We have 12, which is perfect.

**Answer: 10712**

### Example: 96 x 102

1. **Base:** 100
2. **Differences:** 96 is 4 less than 100 (deficiency = -4). 102 is 2 more than 100 (surplus = +2).
3. **Cross Addition:**  $96 + 2 = 98$  (or  $102 - 4 = 98$ ). This is the left part.
4. **Multiply Differences:**  $-4 \times +2 = -8$ . This is the right part.
5. **Adjust:** We have a negative number on the right. We need to borrow from the left. We borrow 1 from 98, making it 97. The borrowed 1 represents 100 (because our base is 100). So, we have  $100 - 8 = 92$  on the right.

**Answer: 9792**

This Anuphant method is incredibly powerful and forms the basis for multiplying larger numbers as well by adjusting the base accordingly.

## 2. The Vertical and Crosswise Method (Urdhva Tiryagbhyam Sutra): For General Multiplication

This sutra, which translates to "vertically and crosswise," is the general formula for multiplication and is applicable to any pair of numbers, regardless of their proximity to a base. It provides a systematic way to multiply multi-digit numbers in a single flow, minimizing intermediate steps.

### Example: $23 \times 45$

1. **Step 1:**  $3 \times 5 = 15$ . Write down 5, carry over 1.
2. **Step 2:**  $(2 \times 5) + (4 \times 3) = 10 + 12 = 22$ . Add carry-over 1:  $22 + 1 = 23$ . Write down 3, carry over 2.
3. **Step 3:**  $2 \times 4 = 8$ . Add carry-over 2:  $8 + 2 = 10$ . Write down 10.

**Answer: 1035**

### **Extending to 3-digit Numbers:**

For 3-digit numbers  $ABC \times DEF$ , the process extends:

1. **Units:**  $C \times F$ .
2. **Tens:**  $(B \times F) + (C \times E) + \text{carry}$ .
3. **Hundreds:**  $(A \times F) + (C \times D) + (B \times E) + \text{carry}$ .
4. **Thousands:**  $(A \times E) + (B \times D) + \text{carry}$ .
5. **Ten Thousands:**  $(A \times D) + \text{carry}$ .

This method, though it sounds complex in description, becomes very fluid with practice and can be visualized as a series of overlapping "crosses" and vertical lines.

## **3. Multiplication by 11: A Simple Pattern**

Multiplying any number by 11 is remarkably easy using a specific Vedic trick.

**Answer: 858**

This trick can be extended to multiplying any number by 11, by summing adjacent digits and carrying over as needed.

## **4. Multiplication by Numbers Consisting of Nines (9, 99, 999, etc.)**

3. Sequence of nines: 99.
4.  $99 - 45 = 54$  (right part).

**Answer: 4454**

**Example: 7 x 999**

1.  $N = 7$ .
2.  $N - 1 = 6$  (left part).
3. Sequence of nines: 999.
4.  $999 - 7 = 992$  (right part).

**Answer: 6992**

This method is extremely fast and effective for this specific type of multiplication.

## **5. Nikhilam Navatashcaramam Dashatah (All From 9 and the Last from 10) - A More General View**
