She received numerous calls and letters from people who had encountered the creature.

As the sightings continued, the term "Mothman" began to gain traction, reportedly coined by one of the witnesses. The media, initially hesitant,

5. **Psychological Factors:** The era was one of significant social and political upheaval in the United States, with the Vietnam War, civil rights movement, and Cold War tensions creating a palpable sense of anxiety and unease. Some psychologists suggest that the Mothman sightings could be a manifestation of collective psychological stress, a shared cultural archetype of dread.

Skeptics often point to the fact that despite decades of investigation, no tangible evidence of the Mothman – such as physical remains, definitive photographic proof, or clear biological samples – has ever been found. The narrative, they argue, is a testament to the power of storytelling, fear, and the human desire to find meaning in the unknown, particularly in the face of tragedy.

The Enduring Legacy of the Mothman

Regardless of its true nature, the Mothman has carved out a permanent place in American folklore. It has transcended its origins in Point Pleasant to become a symbol of the unexplained, a cryptid that continues to fascinate and intrigue. The legend has inspired:

1. **Literature:** Beyond John Keel's seminal work, numerous books, articles, and websites are dedicated to the Mothman, exploring its mysteries and offering various interpretations.
2. **Film and Television:** The 2002 film "The Mothman Prophecies," starring Richard Gere, brought the story to a global audience, solidifying its place in popular culture. Documentaries and television shows exploring cryptids and paranormal phenomena frequently feature the Mothman.
