lays out – the death, burial, and resurrection with Christ, the active presence of the Spirit, and the practical outworking of these truths in obedience and service – believers can indeed experience a life that is not just "normal" in the mundane sense, but gloriously and abundantly "normal" in its divine purpose and power. This timeless message continues to equip and inspire, guiding us towards a deeper, richer, and more Christ-centered existence.
