Whether through Alexandra Ripley's controversial novel or the countless unwritten chapters in the minds of fans, the spirit of Scarlett O'Hara, forever defiant and forever looking towards tomorrow, ensures that her story, in its many forms, will continue to be told. The phantom sequel, in its own way, has become a part of the enduring mythos of **Gone with the Wind**.
