South Lombok (Kuta Lombok): If your destination is the surfing mecca and breathtaking coastal scenery of Kuta Lombok, you'll likely need to arrange onward transport from Senggigi, Bangsal, or even Lembar. This might involve a pre-booked taxi, a scooter rental, or a local bemo (minibus).

Lembar Harbor: Arriving at Lembar, while less convenient for immediate tourist access, places you in proximity to the southern parts of Lombok and offers a different starting point for your island adventures. Taxis are readily available at the port.
