Warriors excel at drawing enemy attention, protecting their squishier companions, and holding strategic positions on the battlefield. Their abilities often focus on resilience, raw damage output, and tactical battlefield manipulation.

Warrior Archetypes and Core Strengths

They possess high health, strong armor proficiency, and access to a range of martial abilities that can stagger, knock down, or outright cleave through foes.
