Place your foam head form onto your chosen fabric and trace around it, leaving an extra inch or so for seam allowance and attachment. Cut out two pieces for the sides of the head, and any strips needed for the top and bottom.

Attaching the Fabric

This is where fabric glue or hot glue comes in. Carefully apply glue to the foam and press the fabric onto it, smoothing out any wrinkles. Work in sections, especially with fur, to avoid creating a messy surface. Ensure the fabric extends into the mouth opening neatly.
